

# SC Licensed Practical Nurse Workforce - 2016 (N = 8,877)


70% of LPNs active in the workforce in 2016 received their entry nursing degree in SC LPNs work an average of 37.6 hours per week - 83% report working full time 38% of LPNs work in Nursing Homes/Extended Care settings 10% of LPNs have more than one place of employment












#### **Examining Titles Within Specific Settings for LPNs in Non-Staff Nurse Positions**




