### **Goal/Purpose:**

This SCHOOLS program will present information regarding the 2013 American College of Cardiology/ American Heart Association (ACC/AHA) guidelines pertaining to cholesterol management. The use of statins will be discussed addressing the patients for whom benefits outweigh the risks.
