Goal/Purpose:

This SCHOOLS program will present information regarding the 2013 American College of Cardiology/American Heart Association (ACC/AHA) guidelines pertaining to cholesterol management. The use of statins will be discussed addressing the patients for whom benefits outweigh the risks. Treatment options will also be discussed as they pertain to various groups depending on disease risk.

Objectives:

At the completion of this session you should be better able to:

- Discuss the new ACC/AHA cholesterol guidelines and how they were generated.
- List the four groups of patients for whom the benefit of statins clearly outweighs the risk.
- Discuss treatment options for various groups depending on disease risk.
- Distinguish between high-dose, moderate-dose and low-dose statin therapy.
- Apply the “Pooled Cohort Equation” to various patients to assess percent risk of a CV event in 10 years.
