## Goal/Purpose:

This SCHOOLS program assists the advanced practice nurse in identifying the signs and symptoms associated with aortic vascular diseases including aneurysms and arterial blockages. Information presented includes the criteria to evaluate when considering referral to a specialist including symptom presentation, interpretation of test results, and the types of procedures available for interventions. Pharmacology interventions in the management of vascular patient care including statins, antiplatelets, and anticoagulation medications will be also discussed.

- Discuss pharmacological management in vascular patient care including efficacy of statins.
