Goal/Purpose:

This primary care drug therapy update is intended to offer program participants a comprehensive review and update of drug therapy recommendations in the following three practice areas: oral anticoagulant pharmacotherapy, Type 2 Diabetes drug therapy, antimicrobial prescribing for common infections. The clinical pharmacology of the various medications in each drug therapy class will be reviewed along with national guideline recommendations for treatment and monitoring when indicated. In addition, a review of safe medication practices, including medication storage, dispensing methods and prevention of common medication errors associated with each drug class will be provided.

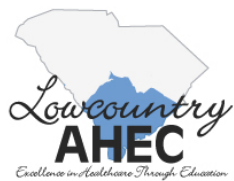
