This presentation will be given by Maureen Dever-Bumba, RN, MSN, FNP-C, DrPH(c). The End of Life Care series (1 – 8) is targeted towards an inter-professional audience. This module, Pain Management, provides definitions of pain, current status of and barriers to pain relief, components of pain assessment, specific pharmacological, and non-pharmacological therapies including concerns for special populations. Participants learn that comprehensive pain assessment is essential to adequate pain relief. At the conclusion of this program participants will be able to:

- Describe how pain happens and how it is experienced by patients at end of life.
- Identify barriers to adequate pain relief at the end of life.
- Describe pharmacological therapies used to relieve pain.
- Describe non-pharmacological therapies used to relieve pain.
