This SCHOOLS program will be presented by Dr. Desmond Kelly, MD. The purpose of the program is to help attendees gain knowledge and skills identifying signs of behavioral problems in infants and young children. Screening tools and resources will be provided in this program. At the completion of this activity, participants will be able to:

- Describe the importance of early identification and intervention for developmental and behavioral problems in young children.
- Define the key domains of development in infants and young children and warning signs of developmental delays or atypical patterns of behavior.
- Describe standardized screening tools that are completed by parents and caregivers to assess development and identify areas of concern.
- Demonstrate knowledge of interventions and resources for children with problems related to their early development and behavior.
