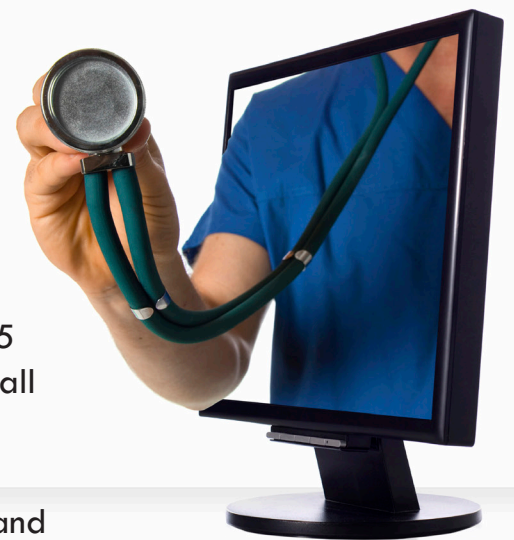
this activity, participants will be able to:
