AnMed Health Family Medicine Residency is a community based 11-11-11 program founded in 1975 in a 550+ bed hospital system. Its goal is to train inquisitive, well-rounded Family Physicians to practice full spectrum care in any environment they choose for their future practice. The breadth of our faculty is designed to benefit our ability to offer excellent education and opportunity to care for diverse populations throughout the entire life span. Our town of 78,000 is on Lake Hartwell and in the Foothills of South Carolina, offering multiple outdoor activities for our residents to integrate life-work balance.

- 11-11-11 program, unopposed, with 365 graduates practicing through the US and overseas
- Sports Medicine Fellowship (2 fellows each year) in conjunction with Clemson University and Anderson University
- Training in POCUS, including adult and OB full simulators and Butterfly IQ machines in all clinical areas
- International Medicine Electives with yearly stipend to pay expenses
- Curriculum Track(s) in OB, Global Medicine, and Sports Medicine
- Unusually deep faculty: 6 FMs who do OB, 7 FMs who do hospital medicine, 3 Sports Medicine faculty, 4 internists, 2 geriatricians, 2 palliative care physicians, 5 OB-GYNs, 4 pediatricians and 7 peds hospitalists, 1 FM – Psychiatrist
