

12 Lead EKG: Do You See What I See?



DESCRIPTION

This course has been designed to provide healthcare professionals with practical knowledge regarding the cardiac system, obtaining EKGs, and recognizing the changes on the 12-lead EKG and how they correlate to changes in coronary perfusion. Course content will include information of cardiac anatomy and electrical conduction system; EKG waveforms, EKG interpretation of myocardial infarctions and bundle branch blocks; as well as the recognition and treatment of the MI patient.

1. Describe the major anatomical functions of the heart.
2. Identify essentials of the electrocardiogram.
3. Identify coronary perfusion abnormalities.
4. Describe methods of restoring cardiac perfusion.
