CERTIFIED EMERGENCY NURSE REVIEW COURSE (CEN)

COURSE DESCRIPTION

- 4. Differentiate cardiogenic, obstructive, hypovolemic and distributive shock with regards to assessment and management.
- 5. Describe the care of various patient populations encountered in emergency care.
- 6. Describe basic principles of disaster management.
