



# Blended IV THERAPY Training



## **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

This blended learning program will teach the participants IV Therapy theory, and the techniques required to perform IV Therapy. Lectures, pre-test and post-test are completed online and coupled with a 4-hour lab session where you are taught hands-on skills to successfully perform IV Therapy. All online training must be completed prior to attending the lab session. Lab sessions will be held at Upstate AHEC, South Venture Drive, Greenville, SC 29615.
