

Course Description

The role of supervisor can be both challenging and rewarding. It demands self-awareness, a solid knowledge base, the skills to engage effectively with a range of supervisees and issues, and the ability to respond to unexpected events. Through presentations, discussions, and case examples, this workshop will equip participants with tools to structure and engage in effective, ethical, supervisory relationships.

Learning Objectives

At the conclusion of this session, participants will:

- 1. Know at least four different types and theories of supervision .
- 2. Understand contracting and structural processes to engage with new supervisees.
- 3. Appreciate the roles that power and difference play in the supervisory dyad.
- 4. Develop insight into personal supervisory strengths and weaknesses.
- 5. Develop skills for addressing ethical dilemmas, competency issues and other supervisory challenges.
