COURSE DESCRIPTION



This program will provide education on Type 1 and Type 2 diabetes, insulin and insulin pump therapy, and the recognition and treatment of hyper and hypoglycemia in school aged children.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES



At the conclusion of this program, participants will be able to:

- Define type 1 and type 2 diabetes and describe basic pathophysiology relevant to school-aged children.
- Identify commonly used school health forms for students with diabetes.
- Differentiate required versus individualized accommodations for students with diabetes.
- Recognize signs and symptoms of hypoglycemia and hyperglycemia and outline appropriate treatment protocols.
- Explain differences between blood glucose and sensor glucose readings for school-based decision making.
- Describe insulin delivery methods including injections and pump therapy and how to troubleshoot common school-day issues.
- Identify ketone monitoring methods and execute appropriate management steps per individualized dosing plan.
- Recognize available state and national resources that assist school nurses in supporting students with diabetes.
