DESCRIPTION

This two-day seminar is designed to prepare nurses, particularly medical surgical nurses, for the medical surgical certification exam and/or assist nurses who want a refresher on current practice trends and the latest information on the challenges associated with today's complex medical surgical patient. This seminar will include a review of the anatomy and physiology of the following systems: neurological, cardiovascular, peripheral vascular, respiratory, musculo-skeletal, gastrointestinal, genitourinary, endocrine, immunologic, and integumentary, as well as the disorders that occur within these systems.

In addition, the legal and ethical implications of nursing issues will be addressed as well as test-taking strategies for the Certification Exam.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

1. Discuss the anatomy and physiology of major body systems.
2. Discuss common disorders of major body systems, treatment modalities, and nursing interventions to include outcome and evaluative criteria.
