DESCRIPTION

This webinar introduces healthcare professionals to the integration of CE-CERT within healthcare settings as a structured, evidence-informed approach to fostering trauma-informed workplaces. CE-CERT is designed to enhance clinician well-being, improve organizational culture, and mitigate the impact of secondary traumatic stress while maintaining efficiency in care delivery and administrative processes.

Participants will explore how CE-CERT can be implemented with minimal disruption to existing management structures, workflows, and supervisory practices. The session will outline the core components of the framework—including emotional regulation, intentional practice, and organizational alignment—and demonstrate how these elements can be embedded into daily operations, team communication, and leadership strategies.

Emphasis will be placed on the benefits of adopting a CE-CERT-informed approach, including reducing burnout, improving staff retention, enhancing team cohesion, and supporting high-quality patient care. The webinar will also address practical applications of CE-CERT principles in supervision, interdisciplinary collaboration, and practice management across diverse healthcare roles, including nursing, medicine, behavioral health, and emergency services.

Through case examples and implementation strategies, participants will gain actionable tools to support workforce resilience and create sustainable, trauma-informed systems of care in the Pee Dee region and beyond.
